- ¹⁶ by me princes rule, and nobles, all who govern justly.
- ¹⁷I love those who love me, and those who seek me diligently find me.
- ¹⁸ Riches and honor are with me, enduring wealth and righteousness.
- ¹⁹ My fruit is better than gold, even fine gold, and my yield than choice silver.
- ²⁰ I walk in the way of righteousness,

- in the paths of justice,
- ²¹ granting an inheritance to those who love me, and filling their treasuries.
- ²² "The Lord possessed me at the beginning of his work, the first of his acts of old.
- ²³ Ages ago I was set up,
 - at the first, before the beginning of the earth.
- ²⁴ When there were no depths I was brought forth, when there were no springs abounding with water.
- ²⁵ Before the mountains had been shaped, before the hills, I was brought forth,
- ²⁶ before he had made the earth with its fields, or the first of the dust of the world.
- ²⁷ When he established the heavens, I was there; when he drew a circle on the face of the deep,
- ²⁸ when he made firm the skies above, when he established the fountains of the deep,
- ²⁹ when he assigned to the sea its limit, so that the waters might not transgress his command, when he marked out the foundations of the earth,
- then I was beside him, like a master workman, and I was daily his delight,
 - rejoicing before him always,
- ³¹rejoicing in his inhabited world and delighting in the children of man.
- ³² "And now, O sons, listen to me: blessed are those who keep my ways.
- ³³ Hear instruction and be wise, and do not neglect it.
- ³⁴ Blessed is the one who listens to me, watching daily at my gates, waiting beside my doors.


