Scripture Reading Matthew 18:21-35

<sup>21</sup> Then Peter approached him and asked, "Lord, how many times must I forgive my brother or sister who sins against me? As many as seven times?"

<sup>22</sup> "I tell you, not as many as seven," Jesus replied, "but seventy times seven.

<sup>23</sup> "For this reason, the kingdom of heaven can be compared to a king who wanted to settle accounts with his servants. <sup>24</sup> When he began to settle accounts, one who owed ten thousand talents was brought before him. <sup>25</sup> Since he did not have the money to pay it back, his master commanded that he, his wife, his children, and everything he had be sold to pay the debt.

<sup>26</sup> "At this, the servant fell facedown before him and said, 'Be patient with me, and I will pay you everything.' <sup>27</sup> Then the master of that servant had compassion, released him, and forgave him the loan.

<sup>28</sup> "That servant went out and found one of his fellow servants who owed him a hundred denarii. He grabbed him, started choking him, and said, 'Pay what you owe!'

<sup>29</sup> "At this, his fellow servant fell down and began begging him, 'Be patient with me, and I will pay you back.' <sup>30</sup> But he wasn't willing. Instead, he went and threw him into prison until he could pay what was owed. <sup>31</sup> When the other servants saw what had taken place, they were deeply distressed and went and reported to their master everything that had happened. <sup>32</sup> Then, after he had summoned him, his master said to him, 'You wicked servant! I forgave you all that debt because you begged me. <sup>33</sup> Shouldn't you also have had mercy on your fellow servant, as I had mercy on you?' <sup>34</sup> And because he was angry, his master handed him over to the jailers to be tortured until he could pay everything that was owed. <sup>35</sup> So also my heavenly Father will do to you unless every one of you forgives his brother or sister from your heart."
