This is a basic home worship guide you can use to worship together in your home this Sunday. If you're musical, feel free to sing, if not, you can just skip the singing parts!

Preparation for Worship | From Psalm 46

Call to Worship | From Psalm 46

Leader: God is our refuge and strength

People: A very present help in trouble.

Leader: The nations rage, the kingdoms totter.

People: But the Lord utters his voice, and the earth melts.

Leader: Therefore we will not fear, though the earth gives way and the mountains fall into the heart of the sea.

People: The Lord of hosts is with us! The God of Jacob is our refuge. Everyone: Amen.

Prayers of Adoration

Spend a few minutes praising God as maker and keeper of all things. You could just invite people to say words out loud that characterize God and his care for us, for example, "Thank you that you are sovereign over all," or "We praise you for your power in the midst of our weakness."
